Note: All outdoor burning by business or private party requires permitting.

AIR QUALITY REQUIREMENT

1. Fires must be completely extinguished and not smoldering by sunset.
2. Materials prohibited by State and Local law cannot be burned: Tires, railroad ties, treated woods, plastics of any kind, particle board, roofing materials, garbage, used oil that is not refined, PVC, etc.
3. Burns inside Klamath County that are larger than 6 feet in diameter and 4 feet in height must have a "variance" from Klamath County Environmental Health, Call 883-5118 to obtain variance.

Fire Safety Requirements

1. Call 882-Burn prior to burning.
2. Burn in an open area away from trees, remove grass and needles around piles to mineral soil.
3. Place Burn Barrel in a open area in the center of a 10 foot circle cleared to mineral soil. Barrel must be vented on the bottom and have 1/4" minus screen over the top.
4. Have adequate water and fire tool to keep fire under control.
5. Fires must be attended until no more sparks exist and the fires are completely out.
6. Traffic hazards are the responsibility of the person burning.
7. There must be no burning or smoldering piles after dark.
8. You are responsible and liable for damage and cost incurred from out-of-control fires.
9. Stop all burning if wind conditions change and become a hazard, over 10 MPH even on green days.

Remember Fire conditions change from the time a burn advisory is issued and it may become unsafe to burn on green days.
